### **Parish Steward**

The new Parish Steward scheme is well underway within the village. Whiteparish have been allocated a Parish Steward for one day a month to tackle jobs within the village on land that is owned by Wiltshire Council. The Parish Clerk keeps a list of jobs to address, ranging from unblocking culverts and gullies, clearing storm debris/leaves, cleaning signs. ### **Kissing Gates**

Councillor Burr presented an informative account regarding the stiles on the public footpaths that are within the New Forest National Park. The Parish Council is hoping to use the NFNP country side access small grants scheme to help replace some of the older stiles with kissing gates. Volunteers will be needed to help install the gates.
