Become a COUNCILLOR

Are you passionate about your local area? Would you like to offer your skills and experience? Do you want to make a difference to your local community?

Whiteparish Parish Council is seeking to co-opt two new parish councillors. The Council meets approximately every 5 weeks, usually on a Tuesday evening at the Memorial Centre. Parish Councillors volunteer their time to work on behalf of their local community. To qualify a person must be British, or a citizen of the Commonwealth, or European Union, at least 18 years old, registered to vote in the area or have lived, worked or owned property within Whiteparish or within three miles of it, and must not be disqualified from holding office as a Councillor (please check with the clerk for further eligibility criteria).

Reporting Issues

To report issues like potholes, dog mess, graffiti and litter please use the MyWiltshire App, the council website at www.wiltshire.gov.uk/mywilts or by calling 0300 456 0105. Reports can be made anonymously, but it only takes a few minutes to register. Registration is free and once you have joined you can track the reports you have made, even receiving a notification once the work has been completed. Wiltshire Council need to be made aware of all issues. Please continue to notify the Clerk as well as reporting to Wiltshire Council.

Skatepark Update

Images of the new skatepark will be available to view in the near future on the village website. The Parish Council are hopeful that the construction will begin before Autumn 2018.

A27 Condition

The condition of parts of the A27, especially through the village have been reported to Wiltshire Council and we have been advised that any serious defects should be picked up on the monthly Wiltshire Council highway inspections.

Faded Road White Lining

Wiltshire Council have confirmed part of the white lining near the school will be programmed for this financial year. White lining must be 80% faded before it will be considered. The Parish Council has asked for the pseudo path to be exempt from this rule.
